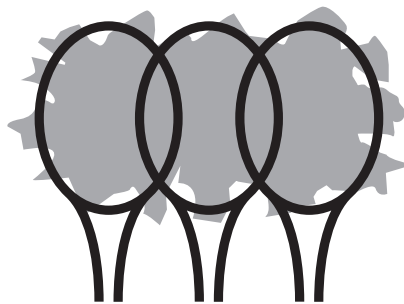


# WELCOME TO THE 2009 SEASON AT THE
